Clarification Note 1- SCMN004/2020 Supply and delivery of laptops to NSFAS students

The purpose of this clarification note is to provide clarification on the following mandatory requirement as included in the bid document: SCMN004/2020- Supply and delivery of laptops to NSFAS students.

Mandatory requirement 4.2.3 “The bidder must provide a minimum of three (3) reference letters, on the letterhead of previous clients, where they have successfully supplied and delivered laptops to organizations of similar value and quantities in the last 5 years. Note that NSFAS reserves the right to contact these references”

For the prospective bidder to appropriately respond to and pass the above-mentioned mandatory requirement, the bidder would need to demonstrate a minimum number of 20,000 laptops that have been supplied and delivered to previous clients in the combined reference letters.

As example:

Reference letter 1 on client letterhead: Supply and delivery of 10,000 laptops

Reference letter 2 on client letterhead: Supply and delivery of 6,000 laptops

Reference letter 3 on client letterhead: Supply and delivery of 4,000 laptops

The cumulative value of the three (3) references totals 20,000 laptops that were supplied and delivered to previous clients.
